

Narrative Research Convivium

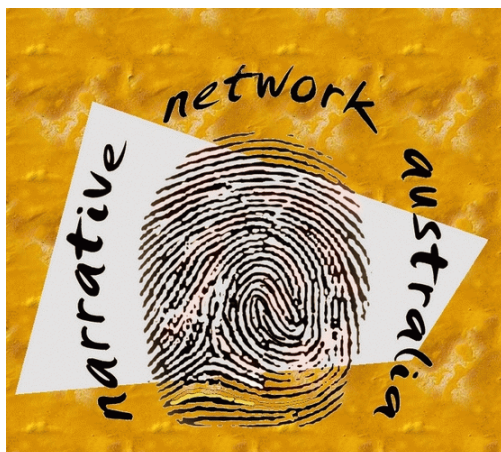
The **Narrative Research Convivium** is a series of facilitated discussions that will provide experienced researchers and higher degree students with an overview of narrative research methodologies.
