- A canvassing of what it 'feels like' to be an abused or neglected child and what messages does being abused or neglected give to a child about who they are, how they make sense of why abuse happened to them, and how this affects their functioning and self esteem/self concept as adults
- An appreciation of what role heredity, genetic makeup, and the individual's environment plays in respect to what impact maltreatment has for an individual
- An awareness of what factors ameliorate childhood maltreatment or what compounds or exacerbates its consequences for adult survivors
- An indication of what support, intervention, and therapeutic endeavors are necessary to assist the adult survivor to deal with the trauma of being abused or neglected and that are needed to enhance their coping capacity and functioning as an adult survivor of child maltreatment

About the trainer

Dr. Barbara Meddin is a professional social worker who holds a Bachelor of Sociology, a Masters of Social Work, and a Ph.D. in Social Work and Political Science (Politics). Prior to leaving government, Dr. Meddin was the Senior Professional Officer, Social Work (Principal Social Worker) for the Department for Child Protection. She originally came to Western Australia in the 1980s to assist WA to set up its state wide child protection service. She has a long and diverse career as a social worker working in the fields of child protection, domestic violence, corrections, education, and youth/juvenile services. She has worked extensively in respect to services to men, women and children and to Indigenous people. She has also been an expert witness in the Family Court, the Children's Court and the Coroner's Court. Dr. Meddin's reputation as a trainer is recognized throughout Westerns Australia where she has regularly presented training workshops to staff in both government and non government agencies. She is widely published both in Australia and overseas in the human services field.
