We are looking for a highly motivated and enthusiastic project officer to join our dynamic falls prevention team. This role provides support to the Stay On Your Feet WA[®] (SOYFWA[®]) program with a particular focus on providing education and support to health professionals. A key part of this role involves the coordination of the SOYFWA[®] Falls Resource Information Centre including the development of resources.

DUTIES AND KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Provide a single point of access through the SOYFWA[®] Falls Resource Information Centre (The Centre) for information and tools on falls prevention.
- 2. Develop and deliver health professional education and training.
- 3. Review, develop and evaluate health professional and community resources as required.
- 4. Collate and produce the Stay On Your Feet WA[®] e-Bulletin for health professionals.
- 5. Engage with residential aged care to develop a train the trainer falls prevention package, with assistance from the falls specialist program.
- 6. Develop and maintain relationships with health professionals to promote and support evidence based falls prevention.
- 7. Assist with promotion of 'The Centre' as a single point of contact through all forms of Stay On Your Feet WA[®] print media and presentations.
- 8. Provide assistance to the Manager, Falls Prevention Programs as required.
- 9. Maintain accurate and appropriate records of all work undertake for reporting purposes.
- 10. Submit regular reports to the Manager as required and assist with contracted reporting requirements.
- 11. Other duties as required.



ESSENTIAL CRITERIA

- 1. Tertiary qualifications or significant experience in Education, Health Promotion, Health Science, Community Development or closely related discipline.
- 2. Demonstrated experience in the development and evaluation of resources for health professionals and the community.
- 3. Excellent facilitation skills, in particular the provision of group based training.
- 4. Effective verbal and written communication skills.
- 5. High level of motivation and ability to work in a busy environment.
- 6. Excellent time management and organisational skills.
- 7. Ability to work collaboratively with a broad range of people from diverse backgrounds including older people, health professionals, the business community and all levels of government.

- 2. Experience in working with regional organisations.
- 3. An understanding of falls prevention evidence-based strategies.
