The tour will visit:

- VICSEG New Futures an organisation that runs programs for families, children, and young people and provides support and training to newly arrived and recently settled migrant communities throughout the northern and western regions of Melbourne.
- **CERES Community Environment Park** a walking tour where delegates will be provided with an overview of the history, governance, programs and displays in this distinctive place. We will also have lunch here BYO or at CERES organic cafe.
- **Two historically and culturally significant public art murals** the Northcote Koori Mural located in St Georges Road Thornbury, and the Smith Street Women's Mural.
- The Koori Heritage Trust in Federation Square—where delegates will undertake the Birrarung Wilam walk to learn more about Melbourne's Aboriginal history and of sites/events of local significance for Indigenous peoples.
