Master of Applied Psychology (Community) - The APAC accredited course at Victoria University offers a comprehensive psychology training program over two years

- Research and praxis drawing on critical theories including: decolonisation, feminism, critical race, and indigenous ways of knowing
- Placement comprising one internal clinic and two external community-based providing experience across the range of individual, group and community interventions.
