## COURSE INFORMATION

The QUT **Law Librarianship: Legal Research** course has traditionally been offered as a 5 day intensive program at the Gardens Point campus in Brisbane, **but in 2014 it will go online!**

This new iteration of QUT's highly successful course will be offered as a web-based learning program **from 10 March - 5 May 2014**, with online sessions scheduled for early evening (AEST) on Mondays.

In this course, you will be introduced to the Australian legal system and learn about the world of legal research. Given the proliferation of information available in print, in databases and on the web, you will develop a critical understanding of the range of legal information resources currently available. Specifically, you will explore and evaluate primary and secondary legal research sources, covering the Commonwealth and State jurisdictions. There is a strong focus on helping you to develop strategies to identify the characteristics of legal enquiry, and to locate relevant and authoritative information to meet your clients' needs.

This intensive **8-week program** is supported by a comprehensive and dynamic learning environment. Beyond the lectures, tutorials and workshops, emphasis is placed on group discussion to encourage the active development and sharing of key ideas.

You can participate in the program as part of your **professional development** activities, or alternatively, if you are a student, you can complete the formal assessment requirements to gain **academic credit** for your studies. Note: if you are already enrolled in a course in library and information science, you should ask your university for details of the arrangements for academic credit.
