Humanities Honours is a one-year program designed for students who wish to deepen their understanding and to open significant career options, either as a final degree or as the first stage of entry into a Higher Degree by Research. It is a program that allows for in depth study, thereby developing students' research, analytical and communication skills. Areas of research supported by this interdisciplinary program include (but are not limited to) **Anthropology, Art, Creative Writing, Cultural Studies, Design, Film and Television, History, Internet Communications, Information Studies, Journalism, Literary Studies and Performance Studies**.

This program supports students in completing either a dissertation or a body of creative production supported by an exegesis. In 2015 the program will be offered externally (online) for the first time.
