Humanities Honours is a one-year program designed for students who wish to deepen their knowledge and to strengthen their career options, serving as the capstone to their undergraduate studies or as the first stage of entry into a Higher Degree by Research. The program supports in-depth study to develop research, analytical and communication skills. Areas of research supported by this interdisciplinary program include (but are not limited to) **Anthropology, Art, Asian Languages, Creative and Professional Writing, Cultural Studies, Design, Film and Television, Geography History, Internet Studies, Journalism, Library and Information Studies, Literary Studies, Performance Studies and Sociology.**

This program supports students in completing either a dissertation or a body of creative production supported by an exegesis. The course can be studied full time or part time, on campus or online.
