BUILDING STUDENT RESILIENCE

STUDENT VOLUNTEERS NEEDED TO PARTICIPATE IN RESEARCH

The nature of work and employment conditions are constantly changing. Growing participation in higher education means that there are a greater number of students from non-traditional backgrounds and all students are under increasing stress as they manage study, financial pressures and job uncertainty. Universities play an important role in supporting students to build their capacity for resilience and develop strategies to manage stressful situations, not just for their studies but also future employment.

Funded by the Australian Technology Network, we have developed a staff program which teaches staff how to embed resilience-building strategies into their curriculum. This program has been developed through a collaboration with Curtin University, Queensland University of Technology and the University of South Australia with input from national experts on student resilience and academic development.

WHAT DOES IT INVOLVE?
